Concluding his judgment, one Judge pointed out that it matters little whether certain sentences in judgment were expunged or whether they gave their opinion that "certain sentences in a judgment were not proper and should not have been written." "The right of an accused person, to be deprived of the full benefit of his acquittal, cannot depend simply upon whether two sentences can be removed from one paragraph of a judgment without mutilating

Judgment or obscuring its meaning. Mr. Justice G. B. Roberts, chief justice, observed that the learned judge had not said, "The learned Sessions Judge decided with the evidence against the accused and was satisfied that it was not probable that the accused was innocent." It is inconsistent with the judicial propriety that the learned judge should find the accused not guilty after finding the accused not guilty. He should then proceed under the heading of general remarks to state that the accused had been acquitted to create an impression that though the accused had been acquitted, yet he may still be held to be in fact responsible for the crime. It is quite possible that a judge, after finding a person guilty or not guilty, may be inclined to say that the accused stands not guilty and cannot be held responsible to go beyond the question of finding a person guilty or not guilty. "Once an accused is acquitted, he stands not guilty and cannot be held responsible for the finding of guilt," continued his lordship. He concluded that the remarks should not have been passed. —F.O.S.C.

HYDERABAD (Sind), Dec 10. A test suit which was filed against the Government of Sind by Messrs. G. Bhurgri and Lalchand Advani, President and Secretary respectively of the Sind Zamindars' Association, challenging revised rates of assessment on a sliding scale, was argued today before the First Class Judge, Hyderabad, Mr. Fotechand Asst.

They challenged Government authority to levy assessment, a leading prerogative of the Sind I. ture. The arguments will continue on January 19.—F.A.C.


